First Eucharist



Parent Retreat: Tuesday, February 3, 2026, from 7:00 to 8:30 pm in Moylan Hall, **OR** Saturday, February 7, 2026, from 9:30 to 11:00 am in Moylan Hall.

Rehearsal:

April 21, 2026, from 6 to 7 pm (only for the children and volunteers for the 10:30 am mass),

April 23, 2026, from 6 to 7 pm (only for the children and volunteers for the 2 pm mass)

First Eucharist Masses for second graders will be on April 25, 2026, at 10:30 a.m. or 2:00 p.m.

Older children may choose to receive the First Eucharist at 9:00 a.m. Mass is on April 26, 2026.

Following registration, you will receive a **confirmation email** with a link to a Sign-Up Genius, which you can use to select the mandatory parent retreat that best fits your schedule. Please note that we cannot offer make-up sessions, and attendance is required from at least one parent, grandparent, or godparent.

At a later date, a separate Sign-Up Genius link will be provided for you to choose your child's First Eucharist Mass. To help ensure a meaningful and enjoyable experience for all the children and their families, we encourage you to register early to secure your preferred Mass time.

OLA Parish is truly thrilled to celebrate this special time in your child's faith formation with your family. We eagerly look forward to guiding your family through this beautiful period of preparation and the joyous celebration of these Sacraments.
